Meaning: Haffle (verb): to manipulate or shape material, often in a haphazard or disorganized manner, or to confuse and muddle ideas during discussion.

3. She couldn't help but haffle her words when she spoke in front of a large audience.
4. The children loved to haffle the leaves into piles before jumping in them.
