

HALF-MAST

Meaning: Half-mast refers to the position of a flag being raised only halfway up the flagpole as a sign of mourning or respect for the deceased.

1. The flag was flown at half-mast to honor the victims of the tragic accident.
2. On Memorial Day, many flags are displayed at half-mast to remember fallen soldiers.
3. The city council decided to lower the flags to half-mast in solidarity with the grieving community.
4. When news of the celebrity's passing broke, many public buildings displayed their flags at half-mast.
5. It is a tradition to raise the national flag to half-mast during periods of national mourning.

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
