

# HALFER

*Meaning: Halfer: a person who participates in or contributes to a division of a task or project, typically taking on half of the responsibility or workload.*

1. The team decided to split the project into two halves, with each member taking on their role as a halfer.
2. As a halfer in the cooking class, she focused on mastering half-sized portions of various recipes.
3. He referred to himself as a halfer, as he was only committed to the first half of the marathon.
4. Being a halfer in the debate team meant she only participated in the initial discussions, leaving others to conclude.
5. The concept of a halfer is often used to describe someone who divides their efforts between two opposing activities.
