

HANG-BY

Meaning: HANG-BY (verb): To remain suspended or supported precariously in a position, often by a narrow or unstable point.

1. The climber felt a rush of adrenaline as he managed to hang-by a narrow ledge.
2. During the storm, the old tree hung-by precariously over the edge of the cliff.
3. She found herself in a hang-by situation, unsure whether to continue or turn back.
4. The artist's latest installation featured a striking piece that appeared to hang-by a single thread.
5. In the final moments of the game, the team's chances of winning hung-by a thread.
