

HARDPAN

Meaning: Hardpan is a dense layer of soil that resists penetration by roots and water, often formed by compaction or lack of moisture.

1. The farmers struggled to plow the field due to the hardpan layer beneath the surface.
2. After years of drought, a hardpan formed, making it difficult for roots to penetrate the soil.
3. Geologists often study hardpan to understand soil erosion and its impact on agriculture.

5. Rainwater could not infiltrate the ground because of the dense hardpan that lay underneath.
