Meaning: Haruspice: a priest in ancient Rome who interpreted omens by examining the entrails of sacrificed animals, particularly to predict future events or guide important decisions.

1. The haruspice examined the entrails of the sacrificed animal to predict the future.
2. In ancient Rome, a haruspice was often consulted before important military decisions.
3. With a keen eye for omens, the haruspice interpreted the signs in the liver of the sheep.
4. The priestess acted as a haruspice, using her knowledge of rituals to guide her people.
5. Skeptics often dismissed the haruspice's predictions as mere superstition, but many believed in their power.
