

HAUSTELLATE

Meaning: Haustellate refers to having specialized mouthparts or structures adapted for feeding, particularly by sucking or extracting nutrients from other organisms.

1. The haustellate mouthparts of certain insects allow them to feed on nectar with remarkable efficiency.
2. In botanical studies, haustellate structures are often found in parasitic plants that derive nutrients from their hosts.
3. The unique haustellate morphology of the mosquito enables it to penetrate the skin of its host to draw blood.
4. Entomologists examined the haustellate adaptations of various species to understand their feeding behaviors.
5. Some butterflies possess haustellate features that are specifically adapted for extracting fluids from flowers.

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
