

HEADSTOCK

Meaning: Headstock: the part of a stringed instrument, such as a guitar, that holds the tuning pegs and is typically located at the end of the neck.

1. The luthier carefully shaped the headstock to ensure optimal string tension.
2. During the guitar assembly, the headstock is glued to the neck for added strength.
3. A decorative inlay on the headstock can significantly enhance the guitar's aesthetic appeal.
4. After the accident, the technician inspected the headstock for any signs of damage.
5. The design of the headstock can influence both the instrument's sound and playability.
