Meaning: Heckle: to interrupt a speaker or performer with derisive comments or questions, typically in a disruptive manner.

1. The crowd began to heckle the speaker after he stumbled over his words.
2. During the comedy show, a few audience members tried to heckle the performer, but he handled it with grace.
3. She was determined not to let anyone heckle her during the debate, staying focused on her arguments.
4. After being heckled repeatedly, the politician paused to address the disruptive comments directly.
