Meaning: HELIAC: relating to the heliacal rising of a star, particularly when it first becomes visible just before sunrise, often marking significant seasonal events.

1. The heliac rise of Sirius marked the beginning of the ancient Egyptian new year.
2. Astronomers often study heliac phenomena to understand the relationship between stars and seasonal changes.
3. During the heliac phase, certain celestial events become visible to the naked eye.
