Meaning: Hellenize: to adopt or adapt elements of Greek culture, language, or customs.

1. The scholars aimed to Hellenize the local culture through education and philosophy.

3. The historian noted how the conquests helped to Hellenize regions far beyond Greece itself.
4. To Hellenize the language, they incorporated Greek vocabulary and expressions into their daily speech.
5. The movement sought to Hellenize the religious practices by introducing Greek deities and rituals.
6. The ancient city began to Hellenize under the influence of Greek traders and settlers.
7. During the Hellenistic period, many regions sought to Hellenize their local customs and practices.
8. Scholars debated the extent to which Alexander the Great intended to Hellenize the peoples he conquered.
9. Some historians argue that the desire to Hellenize was driven by a quest for cultural superiority.
