

HEPATIZATION

Meaning: Hepatization is the process by which lung tissue becomes solidified and resembles liver tissue due to inflammation and consolidation, often resulting from conditions like pneumonia.

1. Hepatization of the lung can occur as a result of pneumonia.
2. The pathophysiological changes associated with hepatization involve inflammation and consolidation.
3. In the early stages of the disease, the affected tissue showed signs of hepatization under the microscope.
4. The diagnosis of hepatization prompted further investigation into the patient's respiratory health.
5. Clinicians must be aware of the signs of hepatization when assessing patients with lung infections.

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
