

HEWE

Meaning: To hewe means to cut or shape something, especially wood or stone, by making repeated blows with a tool.

1. Hewe the branches carefully to shape the tree into a more pleasing form.
2. The artist decided to hewe the stone into a sculpture that captured the essence of movement.
3. With each swing of the axe, he would hewe the logs for the winter fire.
4. In ancient times, craftsmen would hewe timber from the forest to build sturdy homes.
5. To create her masterpiece, she would hewe away the excess clay, revealing the delicate figure beneath.
