

HIGH-CHURCHMAN

Meaning: A high-churchman is a member of the Anglican Church who emphasizes traditional liturgical practices, the sacraments, and the authority of the clergy.

1. The high-churchman advocated for a return to traditional liturgical practices within the Anglican community.
