

HILUM

Meaning: Hilum: the region on an organ or seed where blood vessels, nerves, or other structures enter or exit, or where a seed is attached to its ovary.

1. The hilum of the kidney is where blood vessels and nerves enter and exit the organ.
2. In botany, the hilum refers to the scar on a seed where it was attached to the ovary.
3. Radiologists often focus on the hilum of the lungs during imaging studies to assess potential abnormalities.
4. The hilum serves as a critical junction point for various structures in both plants and animals.
5. During a physical examination, the doctor may palpate the hilum region to check for any enlarged lymph nodes.

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
