

# HILUS

*Meaning: Hilus: the point of attachment or entry for blood vessels and nerves in an organ, such as the kidney, or the scar on a seed where it was connected to the ovary.*

1. The hilus of the kidney is where blood vessels and nerves enter and exit.
2. In botany, the hilus is the scar on a seed where it was attached to the ovary.
3. During the dissection, we identified the hilus of the lung as a crucial area for pulmonary vessels.
4. The doctor explained that the hilus of the spleen is important for its vascular connections.
5. Understanding the anatomy of the hilus can aid in the diagnosis of various organ diseases.
