

HISTRIONISM

Meaning: Histrionism refers to the tendency to display exaggerated emotional behavior or theatricality, often to attract attention or evoke a response.

1. Histrionism often manifests in exaggerated emotional responses that can overshadow genuine feelings.
2. The actor's histrionism captivated the audience, drawing them into the drama unfolding on stage.
3. In many social situations, histrionism can be a barrier to authentic communication and understanding.
