Meaning: HISTRIONIZE: to behave in an exaggerated or theatrical manner, often to gain attention or express strong emotions.

1. She tended to histrionize whenever she felt her opinions were being dismissed.
2. During the meeting, he couldn't help but histrionize, drawing exaggerated reactions from his colleagues.
3. To capture the audience's attention, the actor chose to histrionize in his performance.
4. Her tendency to histrionize made it difficult for others to take her seriously in debates.
5. The director encouraged the cast to histrionize slightly in order to amplify the emotional impact of the scene.
