

HOMOIOUSIAN

Meaning: HOMOIOUSIAN: a theological doctrine asserting that the Son is of similar but not identical substance to the Father, significant in early Christian church debates.

1. The concept of homoiousian was central to the theological debates of the early Christian church.
2. Homoiousianism proposed that the Son was similar in substance to the Father, but not identical.
3. During the Council of Nicaea, the homoiousian view was seen as a middle ground between Arianism and Nicene orthodoxy.
