Meaning: To humiliate means to cause someone to feel ashamed or embarrassed, often in a public setting.

1. She felt humiliated when her mistake was pointed out in front of the entire class.
2. The coach's harsh criticism served to humiliate the player rather than motivate him.
3. It's never acceptable to humiliate someone just to make yourself feel superior.
4. After failing to meet the deadline, he feared his boss would humiliate him in the meeting.
5. They plotted to humiliate their rival by exposing his biggest secret at the event.
