

HYDROSTATICALLY

Meaning: Hydrostatically refers to the measurement or analysis of pressure in a fluid at rest and the forces exerted by that fluid in a static condition.

1. The pressure at any point in a fluid at rest can be determined hydrostatically.
2. When designing underwater structures, engineers must account for forces acting hydrostatically.
3. The buoyancy of the object is calculated hydrostatically, ensuring it can float properly.
4. Hydrostatically testing the pipeline ensures it can withstand the necessary pressure conditions.
5. In the experiment, the liquid was stored in a tank and analyzed hydrostatically for accurate results.
