*Meaning: Hyperbolism is the use of exaggerated statements or claims to create a dramatic or humorous effect.*

1. Hyperbolism often enhances the dramatic effect in poetry and prose, drawing readers in with exaggerated claims.
2. The comedian's use of hyperbolism made even mundane situations seem outrageously funny.
3. In his speech, the politician's hyperbolism created a sense of urgency that stirred the crowd's emotions.
4. Critics argue that hyperbolism can sometimes undermine a message by making it seem less credible.
5. The artist embraced hyperbolism in her work, distorting reality to provoke thought and discussion.
