

HYPERCRITICISE

Meaning: To hypercriticise means to excessively or harshly criticize someone, often in a way that reflects one's own insecurities or judgments.

1. Some people tend to hypercriticise others when they feel insecure about their own abilities.
2. In an age of social media, it's easy to hypercriticise someone based on a single mistake.
3. Her tendency to hypercriticise every detail made it difficult for the team to work collaboratively.
4. It's important to provide constructive feedback rather than to hypercriticise someone's efforts.
5. When we hypercriticise, we risk diminishing the confidence of those around us.
