

HYPOCRATERIFORM

Meaning: Hypocrateriform refers to a flower shape characterized by a tubular corolla that is flared at the mouth, resembling a trumpet.

1. The flower's hypocrateriform shape gave it a unique appearance among the other blooms in the garden.
2. Botanists often use the term hypocrateriform to describe the distinct tubular corolla found in certain species.
3. In her description of the new plant species, she emphasized its hypocrateriform characteristics that set it apart from its relatives.
4. The hypocrateriform structure of the blossom attracted a variety of pollinators eager to access its nectar.
5. Researchers noted that the hypocrateriform design of the petals was an evolutionary adaptation for attracting specific insects.
