

HYPOCRISY

Meaning: Hypocrisy is the practice of claiming to have moral standards or beliefs to which one's own behavior does not conform, often involving a disparity between one's expressed values and actions.

1. His blatant hypocrisy was evident when he criticized others for the same mistakes he had made.
2. The politician's hypocrisy angered his supporters, who felt betrayed by his double standards.
3. She preached about environmental conservation while driving a gas-guzzling SUV, exposing her hypocrisy.
4. In discussions about social justice, his hypocrisy often overshadowed his good intentions.
5. The documentary highlighted the hypocrisy of corporations that claimed to support ethical practices but continued to exploit labor.
