Meaning: Hypocritical: characterized by the practice of claiming to have moral standards or beliefs to which one's own behavior does not conform.

1. Her hypocritical remarks about honesty were hard to take seriously given her own track record.
2. It was hypocritical of him to criticize others for their spending habits while he was living beyond his means.
3. The politician's hypocritical stance on environmental issues was exposed when he was found to have investments in fossil fuels.
4. Many found it hypocritical that she preached about kindness while often being rude to service workers.
5. His hypocritical behavior during the charity event made it clear that he was more interested in appearances than in helping others.
