

HYPOSTATIZE

Meaning: To hypostatize means to treat an abstract concept as if it were a concrete, real entity or to attribute substance to it.

1. Philosophers often risk oversimplifying concepts when they hypostatize abstract ideas into tangible entities.
2. In her debate, she argued that many religious beliefs tend to hypostatize spiritual experiences into fixed doctrines.
3. The scientist warned against the tendency to hypostatize theories without sufficient empirical evidence.
4. Critics of the theory suggested that to hypostatize social constructs can lead to misinterpretations of human behavior.
5. In literature, characters sometimes hypostatize their emotions, creating a more profound connection with the audience.

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
