Meaning: IAMBICAL: relating to or characterized by a metrical pattern consisting of iambs, which are metrical feet with an unstressed syllable followed by a stressed syllable, creating a rhythmic and musical quality in poetry.

2. In the iambical meter, each line flows with a natural and pleasing cadence.
3. His speech was marked by an iambical pattern that captivated the audience.
