

ICEQUAKE

Meaning: ICEQUAKE: A seismic event caused by the sudden cracking or shifting of ice, often resulting in shockwaves and visible fractures in glacial or frozen surfaces.

1. The sudden icequake sent shockwaves through the remote glacier, startling the researchers nearby.
2. After the icequake, large cracks appeared in the frozen lake, creating a dramatic landscape of fissures.
