

IHRAM

Meaning: IHRAM: A special garment worn by Muslim pilgrims during Hajj, symbolizing purity and unity, and required before entering the sacred boundaries of Mecca.

1. I put on my ihram before entering the sacred boundaries of Mecca.
2. During Hajj, pilgrims wear ihram as a symbol of purity and unity.
3. The ihram consists of two simple white garments that promote equality among all Muslims.
4. Before starting the rituals of Hajj, it is essential to properly don the ihram.
5. Wearing ihram signifies the beginning of a spiritual journey for many Muslims.
