Meaning: Illegitimately: in a manner that is not authorized by law or accepted standards, often referring to improper or fraudulent practices.

1. The company was accused of obtaining profits illegitimately through fraudulent practices.
2. He was concerned that the evidence might have been gathered illegitimately, compromising the case.
3. Their claims of inheritance were proven to be illegitimately fabricated, leading to legal repercussions.
4. The athlete faced suspension after it was revealed that he had illegitimately altered his performance records.
5. She felt that the decision to dismiss her was made illegitimately and without proper justification.
