Meaning: Imbastardize: to alter or degrade something, particularly in art or storytelling, by introducing superficial or inauthentic elements that compromise its original quality or integrity.

1. The artist's decision to imbastardize traditional techniques resulted in a unique but controversial style.
2. Critics argue that the director chose to imbastardize the original plot, diluting its profound message.
