Meaning: Imbecillitate: to render someone or something less intelligent or capable, often through distractions or avoidance of critical thought.

1. The constant distractions in the workplace can imbecillitate even the most focused employee.
2. His refusal to engage in critical thinking seemed to deliberately imbecillitate the discussion.
3. The overly simplistic approach to the problem would only serve to imbecillitate the team's progress.
4. By avoiding complex topics, the curriculum appeared designed to imbecillitate the students' intellectual curiosity.
5. Excessive reliance on technology can sometimes imbecillitate our natural problem-solving abilities.

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
