Meaning: Imburse: to compensate or repay someone for expenses or costs incurred.

1. The company promised to reimburse employees for any travel expenses incurred during the conference.
2. After reviewing the receipts, the manager agreed to reimburse the team for their out-of-pocket costs.
3. She was relieved to find out that her insurance would reimburse her for the medical expenses.
4. If you fill out the necessary forms, they will reimburse you for the damaged goods.
5. The school will reimburse parents for the costs of educational materials used in remote learning.
