Meaning: IMMAILED (verb): the past tense of "mail," meaning to have sent something, typically a letter or package, through the postal system.

1. I mailed the invitation yesterday to ensure everyone received it on time.
2. After reviewing the documents, she decided to mail them back to the client.
3. He was thrilled to find out that he had mailed the winning lottery ticket.
4. The package was supposed to arrive today, but the tracking shows it hasn't been mailed yet.
5. We often forget how important it is to send handwritten notes rather than just emailing them.
