

IMMARGINATE

Meaning: To immarginate means to outline or emphasize the edges of an object or figure to enhance its prominence or visibility.

1. The artist chose to immarginate the central figure in her painting to draw the viewer's attention.
2. In botanical illustrations, it is common to immarginate certain leaves to highlight their unique features.
3. The immarginate design of the garden beds created a visually striking contrast against the surrounding greenery.
4. Researchers noted that the immarginate edges of the specimen contributed to its overall aesthetic appeal.
5. During the presentation, she used an immarginate format to emphasize the key points of her argument.
