Meaning: To immobilize means to prevent movement or to make something unable to move.

1. The paramedics worked quickly to immobilize the patient's spine before transporting him to the hospital.
2. In order to prevent the machine from moving, the technician needed to immobilize the gears with a safety lock.
3. The athlete's injury required a cast to immobilize her wrist during the healing process.
4. To ensure safety during the experiment, the researchers had to immobilize the samples in a controlled environment.
5. The rescue team used straps to immobilize the injured hiker before carrying him down the mountain.
