Meaning: Impassable: unable to be traveled or crossed due to obstacles or severe conditions.

1. The heavy snowfall made the mountain pass impassable for several days.
2. Due to the flood, the road was rendered impassable, forcing us to take a detour.
3. After the storm, the fallen trees blocked the trail, making it impassable for hikers.
4. The authorities declared the bridge impassable until further inspections could be conducted.
5. Despite their best efforts, the rescue team found the area impassable during their mission.
