Meaning: To impaste means to apply or adhere a substance, such as flowers or food ingredients, by pressing or mixing it onto a surface or into a mixture.

1. She decided to impaste the vibrant flowers onto the canvas for her latest artwork.
2. The chef instructed his apprentice to impaste the garlic and herbs to create a rich marinade.
3. To create a textured surface, the artist would impaste layers of paint onto the sculpture.
