Meaning: Impatronize: to treat someone with a condescending attitude that belittles their worth or intelligence.

1. To impatronize someone is to exhibit a condescending attitude that undermines their dignity.
2. She felt that his constant corrections were a way to impatronize her intelligence during meetings.
3. Rather than offering genuine help, his advice seemed to impatronize her efforts rather than empower them.
4. People often impatronize those they perceive as less experienced, forgetting that everyone has something valuable to contribute.
5. His impatronizing tone made it clear that he viewed her as inexperienced, despite her many accomplishments.
