2. The thick fog began to impede visibility, making it difficult to drive safely.
3. Excessive bureaucracy often impedes the efficiency of government projects.
4. His lack of experience might impede his ability to lead the team effectively.
5. Poor communication can impede the success of any collaborative effort.
