Meaning: Impedite (verb): to hinder or obstruct the progress or movement of something.

1. The storm impeded the progress of the rescue teams trying to reach the stranded hikers.
2. Her lack of experience did not impede her ability to learn quickly and adapt to new challenges.
3. The heavy traffic impeded our arrival at the concert, causing us to miss the opening act.
4. Budget cuts could impede the development of important community programs that benefit local residents.
5. His injuries might impede his performance in the upcoming championship match.
6. The heavy rain impeded our plans for the outdoor picnic.
7. Her lack of experience impeded her ability to secure the job.
8. Poor communication can often impede the progress of a project.
9. The fallen tree impeded access to the main road for several hours.
10. His injury impeded his performance during the crucial match.
