Meaning: Imperatively means in a manner that expresses urgency or necessity, often commanding attention or action.

1. She spoke imperatively, making it clear that there was no room for negotiation.
2. The doctor advised him imperatively to follow the prescribed treatment for his recovery.
3. During the meeting, the manager raised his voice imperatively to emphasize the urgency of the project.
4. The teacher imperatively instructed her students to submit their assignments by the end of the week.
5. He felt that it was imperatively necessary to address the issue before it escalated further.
