Meaning: Imperceptible means so slight or subtle that it is difficult or impossible to perceive or notice.

1. The changes in her mood were so imperceptible that I wondered if I was imagining them.
2. As the fog rolled in, the details of the landscape became almost imperceptible to the naked eye.
3. The artist's brushwork was so subtle that the differences between shades were nearly imperceptible.
4. He spoke in such a soft voice that his words were imperceptible to anyone more than a few feet away.
5. The improvements in the product were imperceptible at first, but over time, they became evident.
