

IMPERCEPTION

Meaning: Imperception is the lack of awareness or understanding of a situation or the inability to perceive something accurately.

1. Her imperception of the situation led to a series of misunderstandings among her colleagues.
2. Despite his intelligence, he often acted with a curious imperception that baffled his friends.
3. The artist's work was a commentary on society's imperception of beauty in the ordinary.
4. His imperception of her subtle cues resulted in an awkward silence between them.
5. In the heated debate, her imperception of the opposing argument left her vulnerable to counterpoints.
