3. The negotiators found the opposing team to be impersuadable, sticking firmly to their initial demands.
4. Even after hours of discussion, his impersuadable nature frustrated everyone involved in the debate.
5. She demonstrated an impersuadable commitment to her values, regardless of external pressure.
