*Meaning: Implacableness refers to the quality of being unable to be appeased, pacified, or placated, often resulting in relentless severity or hostility.*

1. Her implacableness in the face of criticism often left her colleagues wary of approaching her.
2. The implacableness of the storm left the coastal town reeling from its devastation.
3. Despite attempts at reconciliation, his implacableness made it clear that he held a deep grudge.
4. The implacableness of their demands led to a stalemate in the negotiations that lasted for weeks.
5. In literature, the theme of implacableness often serves to highlight the consequences of vengeance.
