

# IMPEACH

*Meaning: Impeach: to formally charge a public official with misconduct or wrongdoing, typically leading to a trial for removal from office.*

1. The committee decided to impeach the governor after a thorough investigation revealed serious misconduct.
2. During the trial, the evidence presented was strong enough to sway public opinion in favor of impeaching the senator.
3. Activists rallied outside the capitol, demanding that the president be impeached for his alleged abuses of power.
