

IMPLICATE

Meaning: To imply or suggest that someone is involved in a crime or wrongdoing.

1. The evidence collected at the crime scene may implicate several individuals in the conspiracy.
2. Her remarks during the interview could implicate her in the ongoing investigation.
3. The documents were crucial as they seemed to implicate the company in fraudulent activities.
4. Witness testimonies can often complicate matters by implicating innocent parties in a crime.
5. The findings of the report may implicate a larger network of corruption beyond the initial suspects.
