

IMPLICATING

Meaning: Implicating refers to the act of suggesting or indicating that someone is involved in or responsible for something, typically a wrongdoing or crime.

1. The evidence found at the scene was implicating the suspect in the crime.
2. Her comments were implicating that there might be more to the story than initially thought.
3. The leaked documents were implicating several high-ranking officials in the scandal.
4. By analyzing the data, researchers were implicating a direct link between pollution and health issues.
5. The witness's testimony was implicating him as an accomplice in the robbery.
